**THE ROYAL ENFIELD STORY, SINCE 1901**



The Enfield Cycle Company made motorcycles, bicycles, lawnmowers and stationary engines under the name Royal Enfield out of its works based at Redditch, Worcestershire. The legacy of weapons manufacture is reflected in the logo comprising the cannon, and the motto "Made like a gun". Use of the brand name Royal Enfield was licensed by the Crown in 1890. In 1909 Royal Enfield surprised the motorcycling world by introducing a small Motorcycle with a 2 ¼ HP V twin Motosacoche

engine of Swiss origin. In 1911 the next model was powered by a 2 ¾ HP engine and boasted of the well known Enfield 2-speed gear. In 1912 came the JAP 6 HP 770 CC V twin with a sidecar combination. It was this motorcycle which made Enfield a household name. 1914 saw the 3 HP motorcycles this time with Enfield's own engine which now had the standardised Enfield paint scheme of black enamelled parts and green tank with gold trim.

THE INDIA CONNECTION Royal Enfield motorcycles were being

sold in India since 1949. In 1955, the Indian government started looking for a suitable motorcycle for its police forces and the army for patrolling duties on the country's border. The Bullet 350 was chosen as the most suitable bike for the job. The Indian government ordered 800 of these 350 cc motorcycles, an enormous order for that time. Thus In 1955, the Redditch Company partnered with Madras Motors in India to form what was called 'Enfield India' to assemble these 350 cc Bullet motorcycle under licence in erstwhile madras (now called Chennai). As per their agreement Madras Motors owned the majority (over 50%) of shares in the company. In 1957 tooling equipment was also sold to Enfield India so that they could manufacture components and start full-fledged production. The Enfield Bullet dominated the Indian highways and with each passing year its popularity kept rising.

**Summer outlook: Global models hint at normal rain for India with El Niño moderating**

May, June and July may see normal to above normal rain on both sides of monsoon onset First available projections of summer weather for India this year (2024) from major global forecasters seem

to suggest regionally variable hot conditions and normal to above normal rainfall from February to May as currently strong El Niño conditions moderate. The first two months (June and July) of the

ensuing monsoon, too, may witness normal to above-normal rain, with at least one model suggesting this trend may continue into the third month (August) as well.

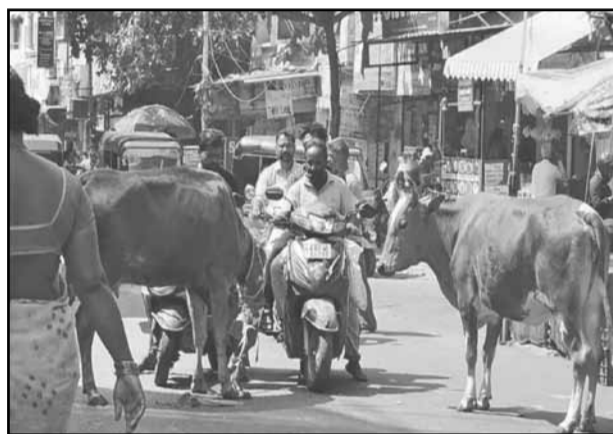
## Sivakarthy turns an action star in 'Amaran'

## Citizen Connect: Stray cattle continues to haunt public in Triplicane



The menace of stray cattle continues to be a nightmare for the residents of Triplicane as several cattle attacks have been reported in the locality. People staying at BV Naicken Street have and are complaining that cattle roaming on the road always threaten pedestrians and motorists passing on the street. In addition, vendors throwing banana leaves and perishable commodities play a major role in attracting the cattle and along with that the hardship. "This has been a perennial issue in the area and there are no concrete steps taken by authorities concerned to tackle this menace. The

streets surrounding the Parthasarathy temple are encroached upon by hawkers, who throw waste vegetables and fruits to attract these stray cattle, which keep roaming and causing threats to the public. Not only this temple, same conditions prevail near Mylapore Kapaleeshwarar temple too. The street vendors are the main root cause for this menace," said R Ramesh, a civic activist. Impounding and putting hefty fines have not resolved this menace. It is always a conflict and a threat to human life. The lethargic attitude and irresponsibility of Greater Chennai Corporation officials are the only reasons

behind the cattle attack incidents reported in the city.

"The cattle owners encroach on the roads and do dairy business in the residential areas with the support of local politicians. The cattle-catching drive is an eye wash by the civic authorities. Whenever the cattle owners see the Corporation vehicle they ensure the cows are tied in their shelter, if not it would be roaming and causing inconvenience to the public," said M Balaji, another resident of Triplicane. When contacted a senior official of the GCC stated that they have intensified the cattle-catching drive across the city, especially in the hotspots including Triplicane, Mylapore, and Royapuram. "If any complaint was raised to the local body steps would be taken immediately to impound the cattle and impose a fine against the owners. In addition, we have given instructions to the cattle owners not to violate protocols," added the official.

## CMRL launches pink squad for women's safety at stations



To provide a safe and secure commuting experience for women, the Chennai Metro Rail Limited (CMRL) has launched a 'pink squad' with women trained in martial arts and self-defense techniques. The women will be deployed in stations with high footfall and also will be traveling with women passengers during peak hours. These changes are being implemented as per the women's safety survey conducted with 12,000 female travelers in June last year. The CMRL press note stated, "It has become necessary to keep greater watch and vigil to prevent incidents of eve teasing

and other offenses against women. The pink squad will cover this additional security requirement for women commuters." "Apart from being well trained in martial arts and self-defense techniques, the pink squad members are also trained in customer service and communication skills," the note stated. For this purpose, as many as 23 women experts have been employed at present, and the numbers will be increased going forward," said officials. The pink squad, which will act as a quick response team at the Metro platform and inside the trains will act

as additional security besides full CCTV coverage of trains and stations, a 'passenger safety intercom' installed inside the trains, and a CMRL helpline 1860-425-1515 for prompt assistance. Meanwhile, this initiative is a result of a four-month survey conducted on various parameters to improve the overall transit experience for female passengers, which was part of the ridership improvement programme by CMRL. During the survey held last year, women commuters were asked on the frequency of ridership, safety while traveling, incidents of harassment, easy navigation of women-only compartments, installation of CCTV cameras, availability of feeding rooms at the stations, and safety while traveling early mornings and late nights. The pink squad was launched by MA Siddique, MD, CMRL along with T Archunan, director (projects) and H Jayalakshmi, Chief Security Officer, CMRL.
